Production was then halted for a year so he could lose fifty pounds and grow out his hair for his time spent on the deserted island. During this hiatus, <u>Robert Zemeckis</u> used the same crew to film <u>What Lies Beneath</u>

Actual lines of dialogue were written for Wilson the volleyball, to help <u>Tom Hanks</u> have a more natural interaction with the inanimate object.

Some crew members were left on the island for a few days to survive and learn some skills. They used some of their survival techniques in the movie for the character of Chuck. They were: having trouble lighting a fire, opening a coconut, talking to a volleyball, collecting packages washed up on the beach, and catching fish.

One of the three volleyballs used in the film was sold in an auction for \$18,400 (United States Dollar).

To see the island that Cast Away was filmed on, put -17.609277,177.0397 into Google Maps and zoom in all the way on satellite mode. The beach that <u>Tom Hanks</u> writes HELP on and sees from the peak is the eastern most part of Monuriki, Fiji.
